Reading and approval of the regular meeting minutes from the monthly township April 11, 2023 meeting.

Supervisor Parks motioned to accept the minutes as recorded for this meeting. Seconded by Supervisor Stein. Unanimously approved by the Board.

The financial report was presented. Supervisor Parks motioned to approve the financial report as recorded for this meeting. Seconded by Supervisor Stein. Unanimously approved by the Board.

Engineer Report – Tom Levine

- Filson planning module had to be revised and the revision was filed on 04/07/2023.
- Received comment letter from the Huntingdon County Planning Commission on the Roby lot merger plan on 04/24/2023. Leslie gave Tom the plans to review.
- Tom reviewed plans and recommended that the supervisor approve the merger plan.

Supervisor Parks motioned to approve the Roby lot merger plan. Seconded by Supervisor Stein. Unanimously approved by the Board.

Solicitor Report – Wayne Bradburn

- Received paperwork stating that the township is being sued by Ken and Dianne Stewart regarding the buffer zone that exists between the Stewart property and Ridgeview Campground.
- Preliminary objections were filed on behalf of the township. The Stewarts have 20 days to file an amended pleading or to file a response to the township's preliminary objections.
- Working on a plan of action for recreational cabins with Supervisor Stein.

PUBLIC FORUM

· Justin Stoner, Ridgeview Campground

- Campground is well underway. All utilities will be live in approximately 2 weeks.
- Asked supervisors for occupancy when the utilities are approved and to approve camper storage in the campground.

Supervisor Parks motioned to approve camper storage and allow occupancy when utilities are approved at Ridgeview Campground. Seconded by Supervisor Stein. Unanimously approved by the Board.

- Will send trash contract to township.
- Stoner has some questions regarding a home being built by Carl Grove.
 Grove is the owner of C2 Tactical Training which is a commercial business with the address of the new home.
- Grove is advertising on Facebook tactical training at the address. Stoner asked if Grove is required to adhere to Juniata Township's SALDO.
- Jamie assured the supervisors that Grove went through all the proper channels to build a residential home not a commercial business.

John Young –Payne, Urban Saddle Ranch

APRIL 2023 ACTIVITY REPORT FOR MAY 2023 MEETING

<u>Ridge View Campground</u>- Pressure tested the sand mound. Minor issue with delivery line. The engineer was notified, and I am waiting for a response.

<u>Chris Confer – Grand View Ln.</u>, -Mr. Confer started the sandmound for new home that will be constructed at his recently subdivided property.

<u>Clayton Cooper 17070 Grand View Ln.</u>-Mr. Cooper applied for his septic permit for a proposed new home build. The contractor contacted me a while ago about building permits and I told him we had to square away the septic permit first.

Mark Savino, 11263 Point Rd. - I have not heard anything from Mr. Savino or his engineer. I will contact him and yet again and if he does not move forward, I will turn it over to the solicitor for action.

12134 Eagles View Dr. - The owner of this lot did apply and is seeking to pursue a land development to add a house to an existing 10 acre lot with an existing house, well and septic.

Brian Chrisemer, 12537 Piney Ridge Rd.- Mr. Chrisemer's septic system was installed and approval to cover was given. Mr. Chrisemer wanted to use the recreational cabin affidavit to "permit" his rental cabin. The townships stance is the cabin must meet code to be a rental for various reasons and the recreational cabin affidavit is not applicable. Mr. Crisimer is going to work with Bureau Veritas to bring the cabin into compliance.

<u>Tim Brown, Valitine Lane</u>- I visited the site on Valintine Lane. Mr. Brown intends to replace one house with another.

12792 Bakers Hollow Rd., - Installing a deck under 30" in height with no roof. No permit required.

Will Roll, Piney Ridge Rd., - Called and left a message about placing a building on his property. I called him back and left a message, however I have not heard back from him.

Timothy Caracciolo 12345 Henderson Overlook Rd., - They applied for a demolition permit to remove the trailer from the lot back in January. G&R Excavating removed the trailer last of the past couple of weeks and leveled out the site.

Jeremy Eichelberger 11684 Snyder's Run Rd. – Installed a car port to park his camper under. There are two lots and set backs have been met from the dividing line between the lots.
