Minutes

Chairman Stein called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. at the Juniata Township Municipal Building and led the meeting in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Reading and approval of the regular meeting minutes from the monthly township September 12, 2023 meeting.

Supervisor Parks motioned to accept the minutes as recorded for this meeting. Seconded by Supervisor Brown. Unanimously approved by the Board.

The financial report was presented. Supervisor Parks motioned to approve the financial report as recorded for this meeting. Seconded by Supervisor Brown. Unanimously approved by the Board.

- Engineer Report Tom Levine Road Repairs
 - Tom reported the he and Supervisor Stein met to inspect Point Road. There is approximately 250 ft. of road that is sliding into the river.
 - Checked on obtaining a water obstruction encroachment permit for the work from DEP.

- Permitting for this type of work is a long process and costly. Based on a similar repair project that Levine did for Smithfield Township, costs could be in excess of \$200,000
- Not a safety issue at this time but may need to be addressed at some point in the future.
- Joe Dinardi suggested contacting the Army Corps of Engineers to assist with the repair cost.
- Butch Dysard stated that the Army Corps of Engineers has been approached in the past about cost sharing Point Road repairs with the township and the Corps stated that they would close Point Road and use the other access road.
- Dinardi suggested exploring grants for repairs.
- Levine also inspected Henderson Hollow, Stone Bridge Hollow and Riverview Heights.
- Henderson Overlook has several layers of chip seal approximately 2 ¹/₂" thick. Stone Bridge Hollow and Riverview Heights has one layer of chip seal approximately 1" – 1 ¹/₄" thick.
- Stone Bridge has strong base, while Henderson Overlook shows signs of water retention in the base and Riverview Heights has a decent base.
- The thickness of each road, by today's standards, is inadequate.
- The issue that Levine found on Henderson Overlook is that water runs to the edge of the road and runs the edge for yards allowing water to seep under the surface of the road causing cracks in the surface of the road.
- To help with the issue until proper repairs can be made, Levin suggested contacting a neighboring township that owns a grader to fix edge of roads.
- Supervisors will come up with budget number for road repairs then Levin will work with Butch to determine which roads to repair first.

Robert Payne – Urban Saddle Ranch

- Payne reported that at the corner of Henderson Outlook Road and Ripka Road water is flowing off Henderson and washing out Ripka.
- Township will look at installing a drain tile.

Bruce Thomas Sub-Division

- Levin looked into the Bruce Thomas sub-division.
- Township has no records of the sub-division. Levin checked with secretary at the Huntingdon County Planning Commission. Planning

commission has no record of the plan being recorded. Secretary will look in the archives.

- Levine thinks that the sub-division was never approved. Surveyor, John Young disagreed.
- Jamie Catanese stated that there were many issues with this parcel of land with power, roads, etc. and he is not surprised that the sub-division was never completed.
- Land is still shown as a whole parcel on Huntingdon County mapping.
- Supervisors will ask land owner to restart the sub-division process.

Urban Saddle Ranch Land Development Plan

 John Young submitted an amended land development plan for the Urban Saddle Ranch that conforms to the Juniata Township SALDO to the supervisors for approval. Levin reviewed the plan and recommended the plan for approval by the supervisors.

Supervisor Parks motioned to approve the amended land development plan for Urban Saddle Ranch. Seconded by Supervisor Brown. Unanimously approved by the Board.

• Solicitor Report – Wayne Bradburn Hazardous Material Spill

- Received follow up letter from David Miller, claims adjuster from Cincinnati Insurance Company, but has been unable to speak with Miller.
- Supervisor Stein compiled a list of expenses related to the spill and will submit to Cincinnati Insurance Company for reimbursement.
- Solicitor Bradburn advised supervisors at last meeting to add a hazardous material endorsement to the township's liability policy. Bradburn asked if quote has been received. Secretary McDermott stated that the quote has not been received but will have quote for next meeting.

Stewart Litigation

 Spoke with Matthew Vodzak, the township's insurance council, in regards to the Stewart litigation. Vodzak informed Bradburn that he had filed an answer with new matter on or about September 29, 2023. Indicated that he had propounded written discovery. Bradburn has not received any of the documents yet but everything from the township's perspective is in compliance with the courts.

 - Extended warranty for an additional \$4,035 and undercoating available which Supervisor Brown highly recommends both.

Supervisor Brown motioned to purchase the truck with appropriate financing along with extended warranty for an additional \$4,035 and undercoating if it is a reasonable price. Seconded by Supervisor Parks. Unanimously approved by the Board.
