Reading and approval of the regular meeting minutes from the monthly township November 14, 2023 meeting.

Supervisor Parks motioned to accept the minutes as recorded for this meeting. Seconded by Supervisor Brown. Unanimously approved by the Board.

• Engineer Report - Tom Levine

Payne/Urban Saddle Ranch

- Levin reported that he received two documents from Jamie Catanese in regards to the Urban Saddle Ranch water system.
- There was a question as to whether the drinking water well for the event center is required to obtain a public water supply permit.

 Levine reviewed documents and then contacted Derek Dillon, Sanitarian at the Altoona DEP office. Dillon informed Levine that since no food is being prepped on site at the event center, no public water supply permit is needed.

LSA Grant

• Chairman Stein contacted PA State Representative, Rich Irvin, and asked him to write a letter in support of Juniata Township's grant application. Irvin wrote the letter to DCED and provided a copy to the township.

Solicitor Report – Wayne Bradburn

Ken and Dianne Stewart Litigation

On or about November 16, 2023, the Stewarts filed a precipe to withdrawal complaint. Therefore, from the perspective of the board and the insurance company the matter has been resolved.

Road Bond

- Township received a request from Brumbaugh Lumber to bond a road in Juniata Township.
- Bradburn assisted Chairman Stein in preparing a document to bond a road in Juniata Township. Bradburn included in the document an additional insured clause requiring that all vendors/sub-contractors in the township list the township as additional insured.

Hazardous Material Endorsement Quote

Bradburn spoke with Tara, Brown and Walters Insurance for clarification on the quote.

- The coverage would protect the township for both pollution and environmental exposure.
- To provide the township with options, Bradburn requested a quote on \$500,000 in coverage in addition to the \$1,000,000 quote that was already received.

Jeremy Eichelberger Potential Violation

 Bradburn sent Eichelberger notice of potential violation via certified mail.

- The postal service has returned the certified letter to Bradburn undelivered.
- Bradburn is working to find a constable in the area where Eichelberger resides to deliver notice.

 - Butch reported that the township was awarded \$70,328.27 in Dirt and Gravel funding for the mountain road.
 - Butch signed the contract today.
 - Butch reported that the red truck is currently at Marks Bros. The auger motor is being replaced and the truck is being inspected.
 - Township resident, Jamie Stuller, asked if the township would install a drain pipe for him. Butch told him if he purchased the pipe the township would install it.
 - Supervisor Brown asked if it is normal practice for the township to install drains for residents. Butch explained that by helping residents install drain pipes, it also benefits the township by controlling water run off which causes damage to the township roads.
 - Supervisor Parks reminded board that roads were not striped for winter.
 Will need to put on calendar for 2024.

Short Term Rental Enforcement – Judy Reed/Tammy Dysard

- Reed provided Solicitor Bradburn with a list of short-term rental owners that have not complied with the ordinance.
- Reed had a few applicants apply for permit by signing a statement that they will have their septic systems pumped in 2024.

NOVEMBER REPORT 2023 ACTIVITY REPORT FOR DECEMBER 2023 MEETING

Kepple Lot 10 Raystown Reach- Received a call from the neighboring lot asking why lot 10 was permitted for a sand mound and they had to install a drip irrigation system. Explained soils change quickly and there are many factors including slopes and soil depths that affect system types.

Lot 10 Raystown Reach- Metz builders have started clearing and excavating for the new home.

Wagner Baha Dr.- Sent two certified letters to Mr. Wagner. One about the existing unpermitted holding tank and one about the campers on the adjoining lot. No response so far.

<u>Urban Saddle Ranch</u>- My office has received the design for the holding tank and the pre-construction permit check list from the architect. The only outstanding item I am aware of is the determination of the need for a public water supply permit.
